

September 8th, 2026

The meeting of the Board of Supervisors was called to order at 9:06 am by Chairman Kent Grabill. Present at the meeting were Kent Grabill, Don Mosinski, Heath Hansen, Chassity Musfeldt, Gareth Stouffer, Sheri Karns, Bruce Haag, Ben Linde, Miranda Bills, Tyler Thygesen, Shawn Deist, Craig Williams, Deb Campbell, Todd Johnson, Chris Swensen, and Mitch Rydl.

Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the agenda. Vote-all in favor. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to accept/file the Recorder's Report of Fees Collected for the month of August 2026. Vote-all in favor. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve increasing the credit limit for Pitney Bowes Postage Meter to \$8000. Vote-all in favor. Motion- Mosinski Second- Hansen to approve claims as submitted by various departments to be paid in the amount of \$143,052.42 and published in a separate publication at the end of the month. Vote-all in favor.

Public Comment was opened at 9:20 am. Gareth Stouffer with the Coyote Willow Wind project gave updates from the landowner's dinner last week. There were around 90 people in attendance to hear project updates. Motion- Mosinski Second- Hansen to approve the meeting minutes of 9-1-26. Vote-all in favor.

The September department head meeting was held at 9:37 am. Chairman Grabill had spoken with Melissa Thygesen for the Wellness Updates. The County had enough employees participating in the required tasks to get the full points for reimbursement. The County Handbook revisions were forwarded out for review last month. The vacation tiers were discussed. Supervisors would like to look at the surrounding counties to compare what they offer. Custodian Deist gave an update on the generator control panel. A few local companies have looked at it to give a quote, and it may not be needing a full panel replacement, but just one of the components to keep it working for another couple years. Sheriff Johnson and EMA Director Thygesen explained all the planning that will need to be done before any work is completed on the generator. The postage meter lease with Copy Systems was approved at a prior meeting, but the current company has reached out to match the price of the lease that Copy Systems offered. Supervisor Hansen would like to reach out to Copy Systems to see if they would negotiate lower than the current company. IT Director Linde gave heads up that he will be converting the County email to the government cloud, and they may be down for a little while on the night of the 21st. Craig Williams attended the meeting and answered various questions from Department Heads.

Engineer Rydl gave Secondary Roads construction and maintenance updates. The final payment to GUS construction was discussed. Motion- Mosinski Second- Grabill to approve the final payment to GUS Construction Co Inc for the LE-8 bridge replacement project between Jay and Kingbird Avenues. Vote-all in favor. Motion- Mosinski Second- Hansen to approve pay estimate #4 to PCS for East Side Drive project. Vote-all in favor. Motion- Hansen Second- Mosinski to approve the utility permit for Casey Mutual Telephone Company Section 3, 11 Hamling Township and Section 9, 16 Exira Township. Vote-all in favor. 11:47 meeting adjourned.
